There is an urgent requirement to survey the accuracy of the estimated bus arrival times versus real bus arrival times. This is required so that stakeholders including Dublin City Council and Dublin Bus have a sufficient quantity of data to ensure confidence in the system.

Surveys will be undertaken throughout the Greater Dublin Area, Cork, Waterford, Galway, Limerick and other areas within Ireland.
